

#### **Annual Education Report (AER) Cover Letter**

February 15, 2024

Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2022-2023 educational progress for STATE STREET ACADEMY. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2022-2023 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2022-2023. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2022-2023. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2022-2023. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given. Our school has not been given one of these labels.

State Street Academy continues to experience the challenges created by the pandemic. Although the attendance had now returned to normal, the extreme

absences that were experienced over the last several years are still having a negative impact on student learning. This year the Academy saw several students enrolled who have not been in face to face programs for the last few years. Although the educators at their previous schools did their very best to engage these students, the reality is they were not attending online classes or completing their assignments. This has resulted in a huge gap in learning. For the students that were previously enrolled at the Academy, the increased absences due to the Health Department regulations around quarantining students/staff who were not ill played a major part in the lack of instruction and learning that occurred over the last two years. Specifically, the key initiatives the Academy is taking are as follows:

#### 1. Curriculum Alignment

a. The Academy's Instructional Coach has established core content curriculum committees who are having monthly meetings to ensure the curriculum is closely aligned with the state standards and being implemented with fidelity.

### 2. Assessment

a. The Academy is in the process of enhancing their assessment portfolio to ensure all data is triangulated for each content area.

#### 3. Intervention

- a. The intervention program will be going through a program audit to ensure intervention is being implemented with fidelity
- 4. Professional Development
  - a. A plan for all staff is being developed that will encompass training for the most crucial needs as identified in the needs assessment.
- 5. Social Emotional Learning
  - a. A Social Emotional Learning program called Great Expectations is being adopted by the school.
  - b. Training will be provided to all staff by the fall of 2024.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

1. **Process for Assigning Pupils** - The Board of Directors will allow students who reside in Michigan to enroll in the Academy. Because space is limited, each student must enroll each year. Preference will be given to: A) Currently enrolled students: a Google Form will be sent home in January of each year. Forms must be returned to the office no later than March 16th. B) Siblings of enrolled students. When a maximum enrollment for a grade has been reached, applicants will be placed on a waiting list and admitted on the basis of a lottery system developed by the Superintendent. The Board of Directors authorizes the

Superintendent to deny admission to any student who has a record of behavior the Superintendent believes would constitute a threat to the safety and well-being of fellow students and staff.

- 2. Status of 3-5 Year School Improvement Plan Due to the pandemic, the Academy continued to utilize the previous School Improvement plan for the 2021-2022 school year. This school year the Academy, as required by the Revised School Code, updated the the School Improvement Plan (SIP) and submitted the plan through the MICIP digital platform, to the Michigan Department of Education. The School Improvement Team consists of core content committee chairs, parents, the Professional Learning Community (PLC) team leaders, and administration. Data has been gathered throughout the school year. This data is analyzed and utilized to determine next steps in the school improvement process. This data is used to conduct a comprehensive needs analysis. Once the needs are determined, specific measurable goals are developed. All staff, under the direction of the School Improvement Team, are accountable for the implementation of the strategies embedded in the goals.
- 3. **Curriculum** State Street Academy was chartered upon the belief that all children are unique individuals. The Academy focuses on individual strengths and learning styles that lead to educational success. The Academy desires to foster the students' ability to learn and has designed curriculum to capture and encourage learning. The Academy has worked diligently to ensure that all curricula are aligned with the Michigan Academic Standards. There is no variance between the Academy's curriculum and the state model. The content areas of science, writing, reading, math, and social studies are taught on a daily basis school-wide. Students also receive instruction in physical education, technology, and music/art two to three times per week. In addition to the core classes, our middle and high school students are offered electives and now CTE Business and CTE Graphic Arts, as well as physical education, band, choir, study skills, and multiple languages. Through the intervention program State Street Academy embeds, as best practice, key initiatives to accelerate student achievement. We recognize that some students exceed the academic achievement level of their peers. In some cases, the pace of classroom

instruction does not match the student's ability level. We strive to provide students opportunities in a learning environment that challenges them appropriately. Differentiated instruction, single subject accelerations, grade accelerations, and development of individual plans are options we support and oversee. We provide individualized instruction specific to a student's ability level. Classroom curriculum is enhanced through core subject enrichment. In addition, optional small groups may focus on preparation for academic competitions and/or special events. Through our MTSS Program (Response to Intervention), students who fall six months or more behind their grade level peers in reading and/or mathematics on NWEA results, receive intervention through tier II or tier III services. Students falling within six months to one year behind receive small group instruction from highly qualified interventionists within the classroom. Students who fall more than one year behind their peers receive tier II instruction within the classroom and tier III one-on-one or very small group instruction outside the classroom. Students are moved through tier II and III, as needed.

In the future, we will work to lessen the learning gap for our students as well as increase parent participation in the student's learning program. We will continue to enhance our communication in an effective and efficient manner. This year we added a schoolwide messenger system as well as a radio system for our transportation department.
